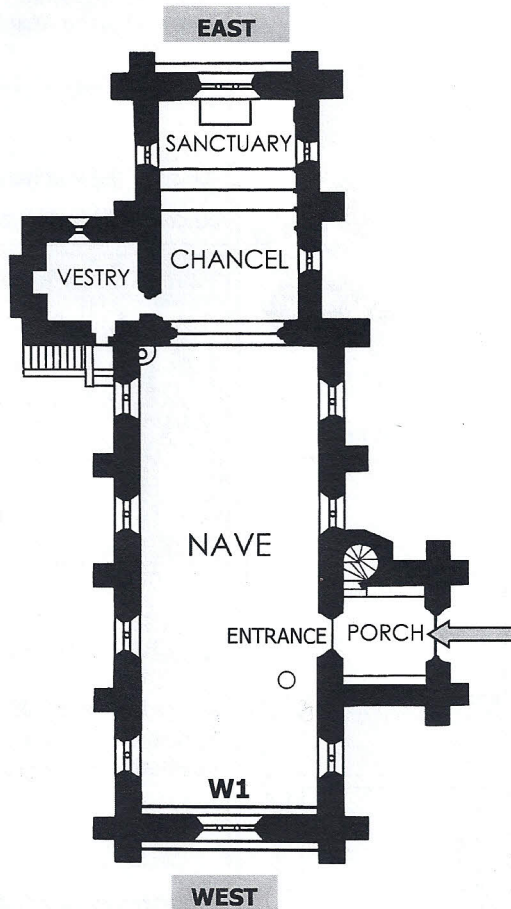

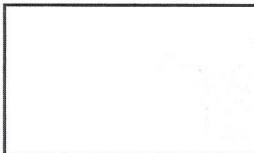
3 WEST WINDOW

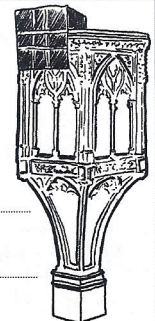
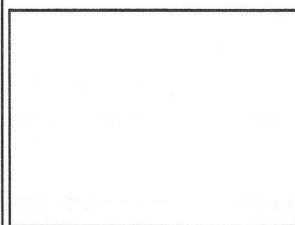


5 PULPIT

How many Angels can you see?

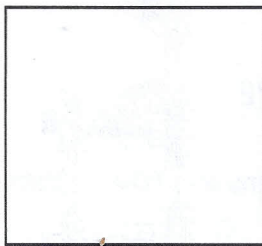
Can you see a Lamb carrying a flag? Yes/No

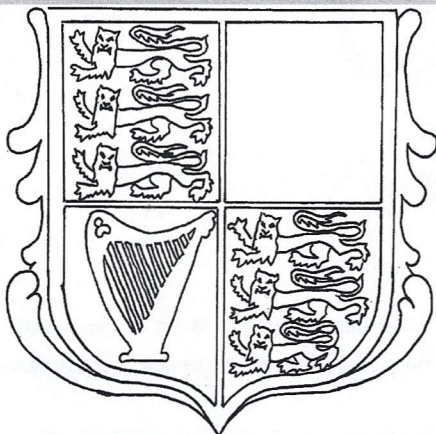
12 ROYAL COAT OF ARMS

Count the candles on the Altar

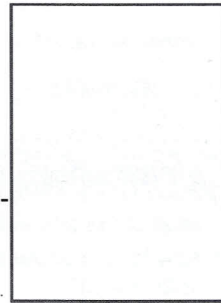

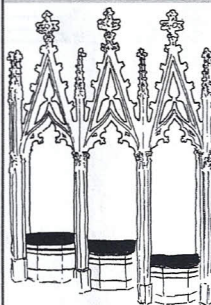


WAR MEMORIAL

Who do you think sits here?

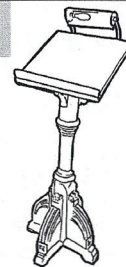


Beyond them is a small alcove.
