Electricity costs so far over the Winter

We are now on a one-year fixed "Business evening and weekend" contract with Scottish Power until 30 November 2023.

The charges are £0.7297 a day service charge + £1.08 / kWh (weekdays) and £0.8063 / kWh (evenings and weekends). As a charity, we pay VAT at 5%.

Since 1 October 2022, the Energy Bill Relief Scheme has given charities and businesses a discount of £0.4667 per kWh. This scheme will end on 31 March 2023.

We have been paying £92 a month by direct debit since December 2021. Despite the relief scheme, this will probably need to rise before the end of our contract.

Finally, after a long period of over-estimation that left us with a huge credit, Scottish Power is using our readings, so the most recent bills give us the correct costs over what we hope will be the coldest period of the year:
